



Dear Hoover Parents and/or Guardians:

Your child's progress report along with his/her winter literacy scores was mailed on May 8th. This will be the final grade report for the year given the school closure due to COVID-19. All learning that has taken place since spring break has been on a voluntary basis and will not factor into your child's overall grade. You may find several blanks on your child's progress report which is due to not having the opportunity to teach all standards. Standards that were not taught during the fourth quarter while we were out of school will be embedded into the learning for the upcoming year.

You should have received an email encouraging you to sign up for a spring conference with your teacher. We would like to give families the chance to talk one on one with teachers about any questions or concerns you may have related to progress reports, learning opportunities or any other things you would like to discuss. This will also be an opportunity to bring some closure to the year for students, families and teachers. Please email your child's teacher if you have questions about how you sign up for a conference. We normally have at least 95% participation in conferences and even though these will take place virtually we strongly recommend that families participate.

The week of May 18 the final learning packet will be mailed home and posted on the learning website. Teachers will continue to be available to students and families during their office hours through the last day of school which is June 4.

Families will need to make plans to return Chromebooks, library books and any other supplies that they may have to the building. Teachers have cleaned out **all students' desks and lockers** and we have all of their items bagged up ready to give to families. Please arrange to come to Hoover on:

- **May 28 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.**
- **May 29 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.**

The process will be to drive on the bus turnaround driveway in front of the building and stop close to the northeast doors. Please remain in your vehicle. A volunteer will take the items that you are returning and bring all of your child's items directly to your vehicle. We ask that you practice social distancing and if you have signs or symptoms of COVID-19 or have been exposed by someone who does please contact Hoover at 641-421-4408 to make other arrangements and do not come to the building.
